

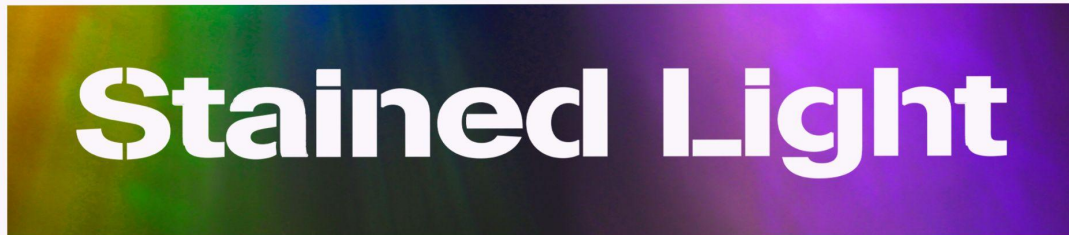

About the Exhibition

There is mystery in Art.
